NEW BUSINESS

314054-Diamond Pond Terr. Driveways/Walkways Change Order Proposals

The DPT Paving Project is moving into the final stages. The paving work progresses and is primarily on schedule. The top coat on parking lots/roadways and pavement markings is tentatively scheduled for July 15th/17th. Benches are on back order and not expected until Sept./Oct.

The redesign necessary for the area designated for additional parking hac been approved by Conversation Agent Landis Hershey and the net additional parking spaces have been reduced to four (4).

Change Order Proposal (#1) for \$1,950.00: Century Paving & Construction Corp. submitted Proposal #1 for a material change from asphalt to concrete for the patio area in front of the community room. The change order proposal was reviewed and approved by Designer Mike Carter today and is included in tonight's meeting materials for Board consideration.

Credit Change Order Proposal (#2) for \$25,980.00: The reduction in asphalt and elimination of the retaining wall in the redesign will generate a reduction in project cost. The change order proposal was reviewed and approved by Designer Mike Carter today and is included in tonight's meeting materials for Board consideration.

Walpole Housing Authority put forward applications in response to PHN 2019-09 Notice of Funding Availability – Accessible Unit Initiative seeking funding awards to upgrade for accessibility a total of seven (7) units within the authority's two state-aided 667 senior/disabled properties.

DHCD provided an initial funding award for \$400,000 based on Diamond Pond Terrace (3 units) but issued a design work order to begin design work at Neponset View Terrace (4 units).

Neponset View Terrace upgrades were significantly more design challenging. The design construction estimates exceeded the initial \$400,000 award in place.

The decision was made to bid the project with a base bid incorporating site work and two (2) unit upgrades and an Alternate 1 for the remaining two (2) units.

The bid results were provided to the Board.

No action was taken at this time on the bid results. Executive Director will further discuss with DHCD possible additional funding resources to fill the funding gap without reallocation of formula funding already directed to high priority capital improvement projects prior to a formal Board vote.
